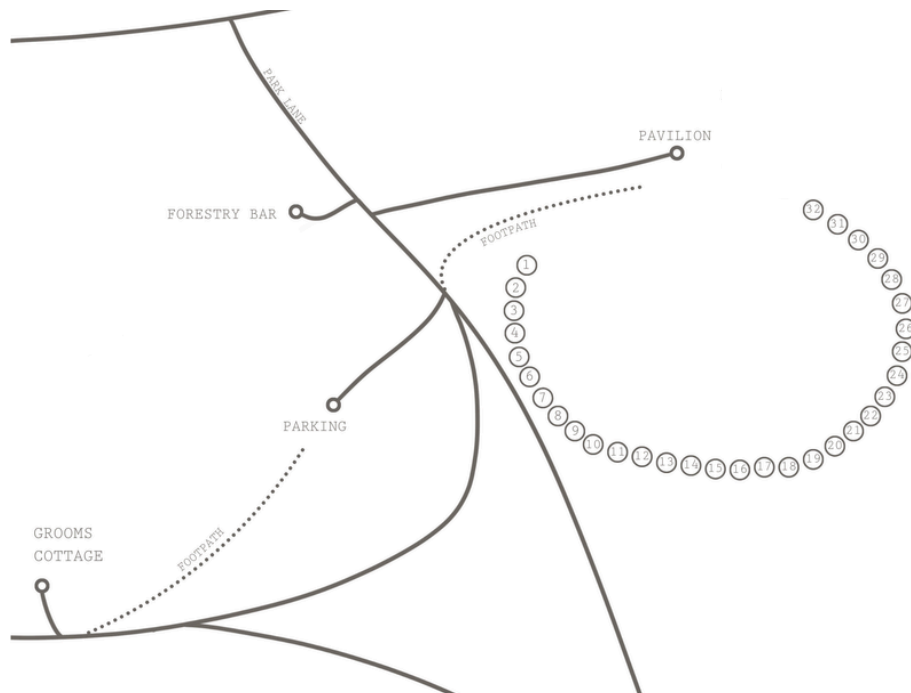


THE BELL TENTS

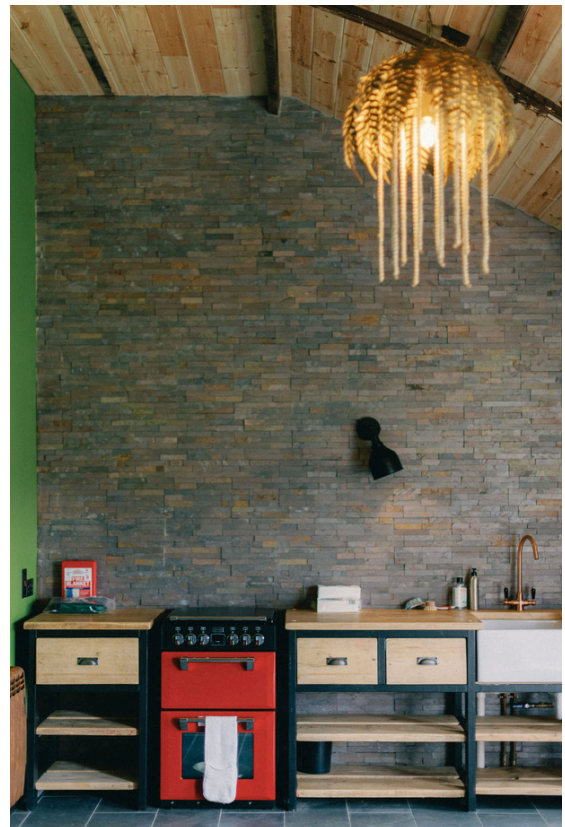
THE PAVILION
